- Fees cover field practicum, student assessments, field tracking software, and course materials. A detailed, itemized list of fees can be found <u>on our website</u>.
- Tuition waiver is distributed across the eleven quarters of the program.
- Students must apply and qualify for Federal Work Study (FWS) to receive this benefit. The
 current amount for eligible students is \$17.14/hr for 480 generalist practice practicum hours
 and 600 advanced clinical practice practicum hours. Individual tax rates apply, as funds are
 received through payroll. Students receiving FWS apply monies to tuition and fees to realize a
 program cost savings. LLUH employees may not be eligible for FWS.
- · Total estimated program cost includes all tuition and fees with the exception of book costs.
- Estimated book cost is \$1,153 for Year 1, \$1,644 for Year 2, and \$858 for Year 3 (full retail purchase prices).
- A personal laptop computer is required for the program (see website for specifications).

Financial Aid

All students are encouraged to apply for federal financial aid and to consult with the Office of Financial Aid. Competitive and need-based scholarships include:

- Elected Student Government and Phi Alpha Officers (\$1,000-1,500)
- Hispanic Alumni of LLU (\$1,000-2,000)

Other Benefits

- All accepted students receive \$1,000 toward a School of Behavioral Health global practice international trip. (Not transferable to other program costs.)
- Certificate in Play Therapy or Drug and Alcohol Counseling tuition waiver with MSW. See website for details.
- \$1,500 book allowance for students with a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.5+.
