

Students may complete a Play Therapy or Drug and Alcohol Counseling certificate. Online and on-campus options. <u>Marital and Family</u> <u>Therapy</u> (DMFT)	77	See notes	3	Fully online program offering classes in asynchronous and synchronous formats. Students must be clinically active but need not accrue clinical training hours. Students must be available Tues. and Thurs. evenings from 6-8 PM PST and 5-6 PM PST Tues. or Thurs. in years 2 and 3. Available in LLU's approved SARA states only and available only to clinicians licensed or pre-licensed as MFTs or PCCS.
Systems, Families, and Couples (PhD)	92	goo hours of professional development fully integrated throughout the program	3-4	Only COAMFTE accredited and CFLE certified PhD program on the west coast. Follows a mentored scientist-practitioner model where students receive hands-on experience in research, teaching, leadership and practice within the field of family science. Students are able to develop focused concentrations in Medical Family Therapy, Community Mental Health Practice, Clinical Supervision, and Global Mental Health.
