<u><i>Counseling (MS)</i></u>	90	450-hr practicum (LPCC only) 850-hr practicum (LPCC & PPS)	2	In addition to the LPCC, students have the option of completing a School Counseling certificate leading to the PPS credential.
<u><i>Marital and Family Therapy (MS)</i></u>	90	500 clinical hours (200 with couples & families) 100 clinical supervision hours	2	Only COAMFTE-accredited MFT MS program in the Inland Empire. Students have the option of completing a PPS credential.
<u><i>Counseling/Marital and Family Therapy Dual Degree w/Certificate (MS)</i></u>	119	650-700 clinical hours (depending upon population served while in clinical placement)	3	Obtain the second master's degree and a school counseling certificate with the addition of only 29 units beyond what is required for a single degree.

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CERTIFICATES

Certificates are available through the Department of Counseling and Family Sciences in Drug and Alcohol Counseling (online) as well as School Counseling. Additionally, the School offers a certificate in Play Therapy (online). Drug and Alcohol Counseling is a post-bachelor's certificate; the School Counseling and Play Therapy certificates require that the student is either currently enrolled in or has completed a master's degree program.

<u><i>Clinical Psychology (PsyD)</i></u>	168	Client contact hours: 200 internal; 500 external; 500 pre-internship 40-hr/week predoctoral internship	5	Follows the practitioner-scholar model. Places greater emphasis on clinical training. Requires the completion of a doctoral project.

<u><i>Gerontology (MS)</i></u>	48	480-hr practicum or thesis	2	Internships available within LLU as well as in many local community-based organizations.
<u><i>Master of Social Work (MSW)</i></u>	78	1080-hr practicum (2 sites)	2*	*Full-time 2-year, part-time 3- or 4-year, and hybrid options available. (Hybrid preference given to those working full-time or living at a distance from campus.)
<u><i>Master of Social Work Advanced Standing</i></u>	53	800-hr practicum	1	Can be completed in 4 quarters. Tuition waiver for first quarter of classes. (For waived courses, students must have received a grade of B or better.)
<u><i>MSW/MS Dual Degree in Criminal Justice or Gerontology</i></u>	93	1280-hr practicum	2	Students take 15 additional units and complete one additional quarter of practicum beyond the MSW core requirements.
<u><i>Social Welfare and Social Research (PhD)</i></u>	92	None	4-5	Promotes integrative and multidisciplinary research focusing on major social issues.

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
